

WARRANT FOR SPECIAL TOWN MEETING

WORCESTER, SS.

To either of the Constables of the Town of Clinton in the County of Worcester.

GREETINGS:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town, qualified to vote in the elections and town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in said Clinton, on Monday, the second day of June, 2014 at 7:00 P.M., then and there to act on the following articles:

ARTICLE 1

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from the Stabilization Fund or take from available funds the sum of \$25,914.00, or any other sum, said sum to be expended by the Department of Public Works to fund retroactive wages as part of a negotiated agreement between the Town of Clinton, through the Board of Selectmen, and the American Federation of State, County & Municipal Employees – Council #93, having been negotiated in accordance with M.G.L. Chapter 150E, as amended, or act in any manner relating thereto.

(Finance Committee – Approved)

ARTICLE 2

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from the Stabilization Fund or take from available funds the sum of \$38,685.00, or any other sum, said sum to be expended by the Fire Department to fund retroactive wages as part of a negotiated agreement between the Town of Clinton, through the Board of Selectmen, and the International Association of Fire Fighters – Local 3189, having been negotiated in accordance with M.G.L. Chapter 150E, as amended, or act in any manner relating thereto.

(Finance Committee – Approved)

ARTICLE 3

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from the Stabilization Fund or take from available funds the sum of \$66,788.00, or any other sum, said sum to be expended by the Police Department to fund retroactive wages as part of a negotiated agreement between the Town of Clinton, through the Board of Selectmen, and the Massachusetts Coalition of Police – Local 151, having been negotiated in accordance with M.G.L. Chapter 150E, as amended, or act in any manner relating thereto.

(Finance Committee – Approved)

ARTICLE 4

To see if the Town will vote to appropriate from declared surplus in the Board of Assessors Overlay Reserve Accounts the sum of \$63,428.45, or any other sum, said sum to defray a deficit in the Fiscal Year 2012 Board of Assessors Overlay Reserve, or act in any manner relating thereto.

(Finance Committee – Approved)
