## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

The Clinton Board of Selectmen will conduct a Public Hearing on **Wednesday, February 21, 2018 at 7:00 pm**, in the Select Chamber of Town Hall, 242 Church Street. The purposes of this hearing are: to review ongoing grant-funded activities, including the following:

- Nelson Street Improvements Project
- Clinton Housing Improvement Program
- WHEAT Senior Shuttle Service
- Downtown Clinton Sign and Façade Improvements Program

And also, to solicit public comment concerning Clinton's application to the FY2018 Massachusetts Community Development Block Program (CDBG). This year's application seeks funding for the following programs:

- FY18 Clinton Home Improvement Program
- FY18 Walnut Street Infrastructure Improvement Program.

Review of ongoing activities will include a proposed amendment to Clinton's FY16 CDBG to re-direct funds remaining from the Nelson Street Improvements Program to the design of lighting and streetscape improvements within the Downtown Clinton Target Area.

These activities are identified as priorities in the FY2018 Community Development Strategy and are consistent with the Commonwealth's Sustainable Development principles.

All interested parties are encouraged to attend. Clinton Town Hall is handicapped-accessible; persons requiring special accommodation should contact the Community and Economic Development Office.
