NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

The Town of Clinton, through its Community & Economic Development Office, will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, February 7, 2018 at 6:30 p.m. The purpose of the hearing is to discuss the proposed Federal FY 2018 grant application to the Massachusetts Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. Under the FY18 Community Development Fund grant proposal, the Town of Clinton intends to seek funding related to a Town-wide housing improvements program and an infrastructure improvements project on Walnut Street. The grant application may include additional activities. The public hearing will also update the public on the progress of the Town's current (FY 2016 and FY 2017) Massachusetts CDBG Program CDF grants. The public hearing will include discussion of potential programmatic and budget amendments to one or both of the current CDF grants. Proposed amendments may direct funds to eliminate blighting conditions within the Downtown Target Area or direct funds to the Clinton Housing Improvement Program. The public hearing will also discuss the Town's Community Development Strategy and Program Income Plan.

The hearing will be held at Clinton Town Hall in the 2nd Floor Selectmen's Meeting Room located at 242 Church Street, Clinton, MA 01510. Any person or organization so wishing will be afforded an opportunity to be heard. Suggestions for other potential activities for the FY 2018 grant application, comments on the outcomes and the effectiveness of previous CDBG programs/projects awarded to the Town, or revisions to the Town's Community Development Strategy may be made at the hearing or before the hearing by contacting the Clinton Community & Economic Development Office in writing or in person at 242 Church Street, Clinton, MA 01510 or by telephone at (978) 365-4113. The Town encourages a broad spectrum of participation by residents and other interested parties in order to better understand and serve the needs of the community. The hearing location is accessible to persons with physical disabilities.
