

**Selectmen Meeting  
Minutes  
April 29, 2015**

Selectman Connolly, Selectman LeBlanc, Selectman Dziokonski, Selectman Iacobucci and Chairman Sargent were in attendance. Attendee was Town Solicitor Robert Gibbons.

Chairman Sargent opened the meeting at 5:30PM.

*FY 16 Budget Discussions: Proposition 2 ½ Override Election Ballot Question*

Chairman Sargent opened the meeting explaining the board will be approving an amount for a Proposition 2 ½ Override Question for the upcoming election ballot. Selectman Connolly made a motion to add a Proposition 21/2 override question on the June 2015 annual town meeting ballot to read as follows:

Shall the Town of Clinton be allowed to assess an additional \$1,070,000.00 in real estate and personnel injury taxes for the purpose of funding the School Department in the amount of \$1,000,000.00, the Bigelow Public Library in the amount of \$21,000.00, a Council on Aging in the amount of \$28,000.00 and Parks & Recreation Department in the amount of \$21,000.00 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2015.

Selectman LeBlanc seconded the motion. Under Discussion: Chairman Sargent reviewed the funding for the Library is \$18,000.00 to support another salary for the summer and \$3000.00, Parks & Recreation funding will disbursed as \$8000.00 for Recreation Wages, \$9000.00 for Summer Park Maintenance wages and \$4000.00 for Central Park Expense, the \$28,000.00 for the Council on Aging will support the purchase of new equipment. Selectman Connolly explained the \$1million for the School Department will be used as an increase in the general budget account. The vote was unanimous.

Selectman LeBlanc made a motion to adjourn at 5:37PM. Selectman Connolly seconded the motion. The vote was unanimous.
