Blue flashing lights at traffic light intersections will indicate when street parking ban is in effect. All vehicles must be parked off the street from Midnight to 6AM when flashing

## When you should clear sidewalks

Sidewalks adjacent to your property should be cleared within 5 hours after a storm event.

Sand or rock salt should be applied after storm to aid traction and to prevent refreezing.

## Why you should clear sidewalks

A clear sidewalk is good for you and your neighbors!

With a cleared sidewalk, residents can safely use the sidewalk for winter walks, and school bus stops!

## Where you should clear sidewalks

Clear the sidewalks adjacent to your property.

Please clear off catch basins in front of your property to reduce flooding.

Please shovel out nearby fire hydrants to increase access in the event of a fire emergency in your area.

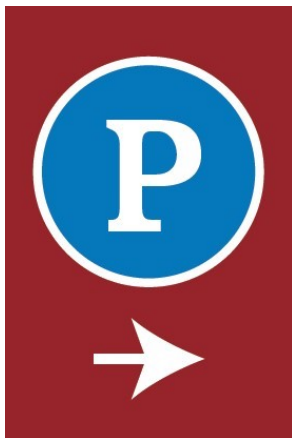
